


Q5: Are you aware of ongoing and/or planned Non-Target Screening activities in your Country?

Some examples:


France: On-going national campaign as part of a National Prospective Surveillance Network (WFD) **Norway:** NTS activities in environmental monitoring programmes, including storage of raw MS-data for later suspect and NT-screening **Germany**: North-Rhine Westfalia state activities, cooperation between German states, IKSR cooperation **Flemish government** - development of a standard procedure for NTS **Slovakia**: Non-Target/Suspect Screening within national water monitoring programme





Q7: Where do you see the potential of Non-Target Screening?



Q6: At what level of maturity do you see Non-Target Screening activities today?



NTS-guided selection of substances for environmental monitoring


Drinking water company's use suspect screening en NTS in monitoring water quality
